



Dear Parent / Carer

I hope you and your families are well; our collective thoughts go out to those who are unwell at present and we wish you a speedy return to full health as soon as possible.

I write to you briefly to update you as to when MHA will re-open. School closed as you know on 20th March and recently there has been much parental and media interest about Primary schools re-opening in a limited way from 1st June.

I have been waiting for Government to publish its delayed and much anticipated guidance for the re-opening of *Secondary* schools. Having now released the guidance (click [here](#) for the link to read it) I can begin to plan for a limited return for some students.

The specified date for a re-opening is from Monday 15th June.

This is for **Year 10 only**. If your child is in Year 10 we will contact you week commencing 8th June to explain how the return to school will work. Government guidance is that only one quarter of Year 10 will be permitted into the school at any one time. Details will be sent to you and this will include information relating to how we intend to protect your child and our staff from Covid-19 whilst in school.

For all other year groups, they will most likely return in September although there is no guidance yet on how that will look. We will continue to provide the remote learning service which many of you have been in touch with me to express your thanks for. From our own school banks of laptops, we have worked hard to ensure that every child who did not have access to remote learning now has that.

Staff will be back in touch after the half term to continue to work with your child with regards to their remote learning.
